

BUTTER STORING APPEARS ACTIVE

PORTLAND, Ore., June 15.—Butter storing has been active throughout the country during the past month, according to government figures just out. Holdings on June 1 amounted to 12,283,000 pounds as compared to 12,000,000 on May 1. This is a gain of 283,000 pounds in 30 days. A large part of this butter, especially on the Pacific coast went into the coolers, higher than butter came out last season.

While butter holdings showed a remarkable gain in the past 30 days, they were still far below stocks in other parts of the country at this time. On June 1, 1924 the government report showed storage holdings to amount to 22,948,000 pounds.
