PORTLAND, Ore., June 19.—Contrary to expectations and past experience, the movement of fresh country produce has been good the past week. Ordinarily the produce business takes a slump during Rose Festival week.

Strawberries are selling at \$2 to \$2.40 a crate, raspberries \$3.25, peaches \$1.25 to \$1.50 a box, apricots \$2.50 a box, new granatins applied \$2.25 a box and currants \$2.50 a crate.
