Civil Service Will Hold Examination

The United States Civil Service commission announces a competitive examination for park naturalist. Receipt of applications for the park naturalist examination will close Jan. 25, 1929. The date for assembling of competitors will be stated on the admission cards sent applicants after the close of receipt of applications. The examination is to fill vacancies in the national park service at Glacier National Park, Mont., and Rainier National Park, Wash., at \$2000-2500 a year, less \$180 a year for quarters, fuel and light, and in positions requiring similar qualifications. Full information and application blanks may be obtained from the secretary, eleventh U. S. civil service district, 207 Postoffice building, Seattle, Wash., or the secretary of the board of U. S. civil service examiners, at any first or second class postoffice within this district.
