LOCAL MARKETS SHOW LITTLE CHANGE

PORTLAND MARKS STEADY MONDAY

PORTLAND, July 29.—(AP)—Receipts of the first consignment of Elberta and Crawford peaches from California was reported today. They were wholesaling for \$1.00 to \$1.15 a box. Apricots, with supplies plentiful and the coming season at hand, were quoted at 90 cents. Butternut, eggs, poultry and fresh meats were unchanged. Trade was fair at the East side market of the Gardeners and Ranchers' association with prices little changed from those of Saturday. Tomatoes, apricots and peaches were easier, while raspberries and blackberries regained the decline of last week. Prices quoted were: peas 7; beans 7; corn \$2.75 for sack of 48; alfalfa \$1.15; lettuce \$1; cabbage \$1; celery 90 cents; cucumbers 50 cents; raspberries \$2.25; blackberries \$1.75; apricots \$1.00; onions 40; carrots \$1.25; turnips 45; apples 80; summer squash \$1; potatoes \$1.75; peaches \$1.25; eggplant \$1.75; peppers \$1; asparagus \$1.50.

CHICAGO GRAIN

CHICAGO, July 29.—(AP)—Drought and heat sent grain values still higher early today, with corn overcoming the season's high price record. In the wheat market, a feature was news that Nebraska threshing returns are running far below expectations. Opening 5-8¢ to 13-4¢ up, wheat reacted somewhat but quickly advanced again. Corn started 3-8¢ to 1-4¢ rise, and afterward continued to mount. Oats also developed strength. Provisions declined. Wheat closed irregular at the same as Saturday's final to 2-7-8 lower. Corn closed at 1-1-4 up and provisions unchanged to 1-2¢ down.
