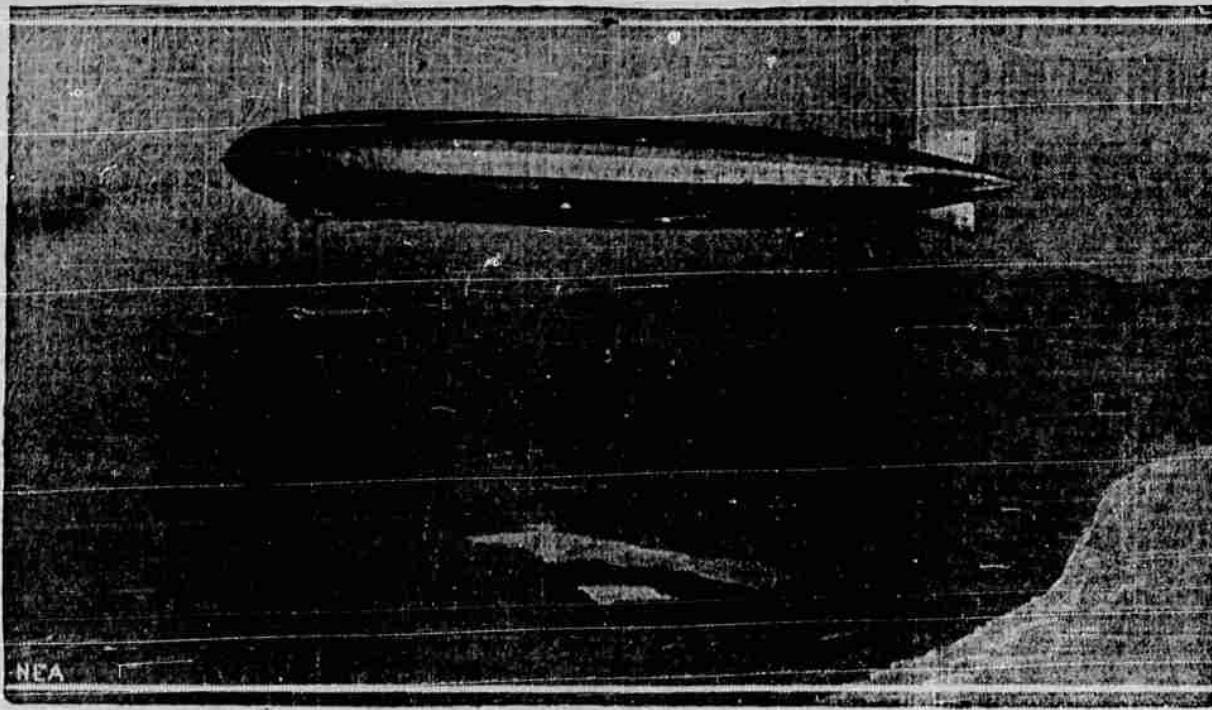


WHEN THE GREAT ZEP HOVERED OVER GOLDEN GATE IN THE SOFT GLOW OF SUNSET

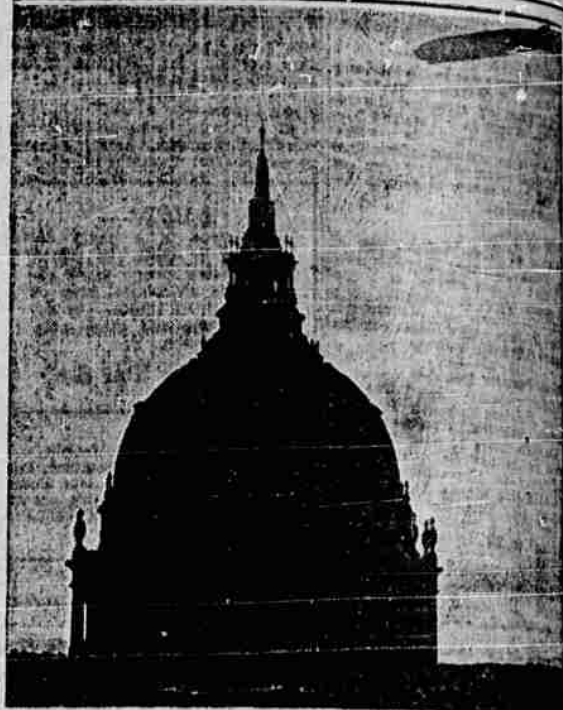


The Graf Zeppelin not only shattered all records for Trans-Pacific travel in its hop from Tokyo to Los Angeles, but it also almost jumped a day ahead of its original schedule. Although it was Sunday with the staff somewhat scattered, the NEA Bureau at San Francisco, which serves The Eugene Guard, rallied its aviators, its air cameras, its other photographers, its autos, engravers, stereo-
