Diphtheria germs are killed at 181 degrees, sore throat germs at 184 degrees, typhoid germs at 187 degrees, tuberculosis germs at 139 degrees. Pasteurized milk is heated to 143 degrees and never boiled—the boiling point is 212 degrees.
