WHILE THE PRICE IS BEING SHARDED
While the general price level is being sharded, the market for broilers remains at 25c a pound, some sales are reported a fraction below the previous quotations in other lines.

CHICKEN PRICES
With the expected arrival of a full carload of green peas from the Hayward, Cal., section, the market for the present value on best quality peas are expected to be in the range of 20 to 25 c a pound, marking an unusually low price.

LOCAL ASPARAGUS SCARCER HERE
Scarcity of home-grown asparagus is shown here, with most of the sales at 32.25 to 32.50 per dozen bunches. Walls' Walla pyramids are selling at 30 to 32 c a dozen, while California stock is available at various low prices.
