SHINGLE MILL DESTROYED

DELTA PLANT ON THE SUGAR BURNS TO GROUND
Loss is Estimated at \$50,000 and \$30,000 Insurance is Carried—May Be Rebuilt

CUSHMAN, Ore., May 22.—The mill of the Delta Shingle company, at the mouth of the North Fork, between here and Florence, was burned to the ground early this morning. It is not known definitely how the fire originated, but it is presumed that it started in the furnace room.

The fire had gained such headway when discovered that it was impossible to save anything. The loss is estimated at about \$50,000, and it is reported that the company carried \$30,000 insurance on the plant. This company has been particularly unfortunate in regard to fire losses. About a year ago the dry kiln at the plant was burned.

It is not known whether or not the mill will be rebuilt, but as there is a good market for shingles, and as the plant had been doing a big business for a long time, it is expected that another plant will soon rise.

The late John W. Bergman, Florence, was president of the Delta Shingle company for a long time, and his interest in the plant is retained by members of the family.

HIGHWAY WORK UNDER WAY

SCANDIA COMPANY TO BUILD HALSEY TO HARRISBURG

HARRISBURG, Ore., May 22.—The Scandia Shipbuilding company are now at work on the building of the highway from Halsey to here. Arrangements were made with Warren Norton to acquire the gravel. A crew of men have cleared off the brush and begun the erection of the bunkers Wednesday and the rock crushing machinery is expected to be all put in within two weeks. Local men are being employed as much as possible. Offices have been secured for the company over the First National bank at the rear of the Dr. Kent office. Mr. Skogberg, the company's manager and D. Douglas, secretary, have arrived and are working on preparations for the big job.

Highway engineers have arrived and have established their office at the rear of the Bulletin office. G. E. Farnsworth will have charge of the crew here which will consist of three to five men.

JUNCTION ROAD LAID OVER

PROJECT HELD TOO EXPENSIVE FOR THIS YEAR

The new Pacific highway between Junction City and Harrisburg will not be built this year, if the recommendations of the Lane county board to the state highway commission are carried out, according to announcement yesterday by members of the court.

This was included in the program of co-operative construction between the county and state for this year, but the members of the court have decided that both the right-of-way and construction will cost more than was anticipated.

The county court had allotted \$21,000 of the bond money for this part of the highway, but estimates of the cost are as high as \$25,000 or \$30,000. This would necessitate the taking of the difference from the county bridge fund, the members of the court state, and would cause a curtailment of bridge construction to that extent.

Mr. Hayley opens his concert with Franz von Suppe's classic, "Poet and Peasant" overture, which is followed with lighter numbers, "Sparkles" with "The Wurlitzer" as the finale. The concert will be featured on today and Wednesday's program.

"The Face Between," which opened yesterday at the Castle theatre, in a picture which wins the support of those who believe in the movies as an

institution with limitless possibilities for intelligent entertainment. In this picture, in which Bert Lytell heads the cast, there is unfolded a story which has the elements of universal popularity and which grows in interest and suspense with a logical development and a regard for the plausibilities which is too often ignored by the scenario writers.
