MONTH WOULD HAVE BEEN BELOW NORMAL WITHOUT IT

Weather Man Says Most Days Aside from Those of Latter Part of Month Were Cold

Had it not been for the recent two periods of unseasonable weather the mean temperature for May this year would have been several degrees below normal, according to Leo Goetschius, local weather observer, because the rest of the month was real cool.

The maximum temperature during this month was 81 degrees on the 20th and the minimum was 25 on the 8th and 22nd. There were 14 clear days, three partly clear days and 14 cloudy days and light frosts occurred on the 22nd and 26th. No damage was done. There was a light hail on the 8th. The prevailing direction of the wind was from the northwest.
