Miss Margaret Land gave a reading entitled "The Hatchet Story." A dialogue on Lincoln and Washington was given by Wayne McCue and Albert Smith. Then followed a song, "All Hail the Name of Lincoln."

Record of Speeches Given

A gramophone record was given of Lincoln's Gettysburg speech given by Mr. Humphrey. Miss Mildred Robinson gave a reading entitled "Oh Captain, My Captain."

Frances Emerson gave a fine violin selection accompanied by her sister, Miss Lois Emerson. Great preparations had been made in the next two numbers, the first being a Washington Drama given by several of the students. George Washington and his mother, Mary Washington, were present, both

splendidly made up. Guy Griswold representing Washington and Christine Robinson substituting for Amelia Forbes who was sick, made a fine Martha Washington. Several were backed up on a plantation folk and led by Leon Morris sang negro melodies with old time zeal and fervor. Three girls, Evelyn York, who represented Miss Custis, and Helen McGee and Elizabeth Sedgwick, who represented neighbor girls, were dressed in white costumes and sang songs and danced the minuet making a most pleasing feature of the program. Kenneth Schwerling, in high collar, was a faithful bodyguard to Martha Washington, who sang a song very quaintly and well adapted to the part. The second big feature of the program was a drill by thirteen girls, paying obedience to the flag and Uncle Sam splendidly impersonated by Leonard Ferguson and Betty Ross, represented by Iva Poiry. The girls were dressed in white with an even chain or rope which they manipulated into pleasing positions. Their drill was a difficult mingling of rhythmic movements perfectly executed. Each girl represented one of the original thirteen states. They were led by Stella Maaranen, who fixed the steps and movements they should take. The teachers of these grades, Miss Dale, of the seventh, and Mrs. Perini, of the eighth, had been untiring in their work of preparation. The program closed with America and a fine salute to the flag.

P-T-A MEETING IS HELD

CREWELL, Ore., Feb. 23.—The Parent-Teacher association held its regular meeting at the high school Thursday evening and it was one of the best attended of the about seventy-five people being present. It was "daddy's night" and the daddies were there. The program was in charge of the men, a committee consisting of H. C. Travillion, H. A. Howe and C. H. Sedgwick having arranged the program.

The meeting opened with Mrs. Lila Miller presiding, and the routine business was soon dispensed with and the meeting turned over to the committee.

The first number was a song, the old original words of Yankee Doodle arranged around the Boston tea party episode. This was sung by E. Harding and the chorus responded nobly with a fine chorus. H. A. Howe, member of the school board, in a few well chosen words, urged the men to take interest in the P-T-A. speaking of the responsibility and energy assumed by the women heretofore along educational lines and emphasizing the fact that when a tax was considered for the betterment and improvement of the schools it was too often opposed by the men who had not stopped to consider the real benefits derived from deliberate consideration of means to further educational facilities. A male quartet consisting of E. Harding, H. C. Travillion, Ed Weber and C. H. Sedgwick with Leo Land accompanying, sang an appropriate song entitled, "The Men and the Schools." They responded with a chant encore.

Judge Skipworth Is Speaker

The speaker of the evening was Judge G. F. Skipworth, of Eugene, who gave a masterly address which was full of meat and held the attention of the audience throughout. His address was a denunciation of the lines and burden of the church work and educational work in the schools being assumed by the women and how much was due them for the faithfulness of their interest. That with advancing years had come new responsibilities and the burden of citizenship and it was now incumbent on the men to share with the women and help assume these responsibilities. He showed how the United States constitution had stood the test of time and was the foundation of God given liberties which men failed to appreciate. One of these had been the development of educational privileges in the public schools and colleges. The first schools were promoted by the Pilgrims fathers who came over in 1620 and the religious education of the children was the first state to legislate on the subject. Then came the strife over the segregation of the school from the religious leadership to that of the state where it properly belonged and that state, one by one, passed laws promoting the public school.

Disregard for Law Deplored

The great menace today is the disregard for law and order and a lack of appreciation of the great privileges and rights guaranteed to citizens by this great document.

Mr. Skipworth then turned to the criminal today was astounding. The young—in Lane county being an average of only twenty years. These young men committed all varieties of crimes from stealing to murder. The great work at hand was to correct this evil. The first point of attack is the home and the next place is the public school. Let the school teach patriotism and the principles of the constitution and let the fathers and mothers set the example. Every man in the state should get behind the work of the public parent-teacher association. Let no scholar be discouraged but when down think of Lincoln who was among the poorest of the poor yet the greatest of the great. These years commemorating the great men like Washington and Lincoln should be observed with patriotic and fervent interest. The men then sang "Good Night Ladies," after which a social hour was enjoyed, light refreshments of punch and hatchet cookies further celebrating the day.
