LIBRARY IS POPULAR

REAL SERVICE IS OFFERED TO SPRINGFIELD FOLK

1673 Volumes on Shelves at Present—200 Persons Visit Room on Open Days

(Register Lane County Special) SPRINGFIELD, Ore., April 21.—The Springfield library, which is open every Wednesday and Saturday afternoons, now has a collection of 1673 volumes and several current magazines, and is used by nearly 200 persons each day that it is opened, according to Mary Roberts, librarian.

In addition to the service of the books on the shelves, the library will also obtain volumes and periodicals from the state library at Salem, and from the university library at Eugene upon request. Files of daily newspapers are also open to the public.

"The library is here for the service of the people of Springfield and vicinity," said Miss Roberts, "and we want everyone to feel free to come here."

The library is quite extensively used by out-of-town people, Miss Roberts said, and material of special interest to children, such as children's books, bird pictures, maps, etc., is a special feature that is well cared for.

TRAILER IS HIT BY TRAIN

BIG TRUCK FAILS TO BEAT FREIGHT TO CROSSING

(Register Lane County Special) CRESWELL, Ore., April 21.—A heavy gravel truck with a trailer attempted to make the crossing at Creswell ahead of a freight train Saturday morning about 10:30. The truck belonged to the Mosair Trucking company of Tacoma. The trailer was struck by the freight and severed from the truck, carried several feet along the depot platform and was literally demolished. One of the wheels was broken and the crankcase split and the contents of the trailer scattered in all directions.

The truck with trailer was coming from the south on the Pacific highway and the freight with 75 cars was also coming north. A freight headed south was standing on the siding with the caboose a few feet from the crossing which obscured the moving train from the travelers on the highway. Fortunately no one was hurt although it was a narrow escape of several who were near at hand. Clyde Smith, the local drayman just escaped being hit by backing into the platform.
