30 AT CHAMBER MEETING

SPRINGFIELD MEMBERS HEAR OF POSTAL INCREASES

Note of Optimism Sounded at Civic Gathering—Various Committees Report

SPRINGFIELD, Ore., July 24.—Over 30 members were present at the regular meeting of the chamber of commerce held here last night. The affair opened with a banquet at the Elks restaurant, following which Postmaster F. B. Hamilton gave an interesting talk on postal conditions in this city. A substantial increase in receipts has been shown during the past year, said Mr. Hamilton, and it is expected that Springfield will soon be in the second class postal rating.

At the meeting held following the banquet and talk, the sign committee reported that work was

progressing on this project. The sign is to be placed on the hill overlooking the main highway. The publicity committee also discussed plans for the booklet to be issued concerning the city material for which is now being gathered.

The extension of the fire limits was also brought up at this time, and it was voted to ask the city council to extend the limits. An early repaving of Main street, which is getting worse every day, was urged at the meeting, and the chamber was assured that this work would be done in the near future. The contract for the repaving was let some time ago to Force and Curran, contractors, who are doing the road work between here and Eugene.

The meeting was filled with the new spirit of optimism that has invaded this city, and an even greater attendance is expected at the next meeting, states W. E. Walker, president of the chamber.

Very slow sale is shown here for spring ducks, with receivers asking 15¢ to 17¢ pound, but with few takers. Demand for chickens continues firm with the trade active at full prices.

MEAT MARKETS HOLD WELL
All through the market for country-killed calves a firm tone is ruling because of the very limited offerings. Sales generally at 15¢ for tops, with a few deals below or above this price. Hogs also firm.
