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AGED DIVINE TO LEAVE

CALIFORNIA VISITOR GOES TO HOME IN SOUTH

Rev. Joseph Emery, For 50 Years a Minister of the Church, Recalls Early Days at O. A. C.

After a visit of about three months with his children and grandchildren in this city, Rev. Joseph Emery, of Hollister, California, leaves tomorrow for his home. Rev. Mr. Emery, who has passed his 91st birthday anniversary, has been a minister of the Methodist church of the South for the past 56 years, being ordained in California in 1867, the year that he came to Oregon and settled at Corvallis, where, for the next 18 years he was connected with educational work at the Oregon Agricultural college. The Oregon state college at that time was housed in one building, and Rev. Mr. Emery recalls the early struggles for existence of the little college.

Mr. Emery was also connected with Indian agency work at Klamath for six years and organized the first grade schools for the Indian children in that district. He also supervised over 500 small farms that were later cultivated by the government wards under his direction. The aged divine was the guest of the class of 1922 at the annual commencement of O. A. C. last June. He came to the Pacific Coast in 1865, following his graduation from Jefferson college in Pennsylvania. He has three children living, nine grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.

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HAWAII WILL FIGHT FOR RIGHTS AS TERRITORY

Concerted Campaign for Recognition is Started

Reason for Procedure is Claim that Critical Situation is Faced in Peary Isles

HONOLULU, Aug. 7.—A concerted campaign to obtain recognition of Hawaii's status as a territory and its rights to the benefits and privileges enjoyed by states as set forth in the measure adopted by the recent legislature, which is known as "Hawaii's Bill of Rights," is being waged by Governor Wallace H. Farrington and other territorial officials.

The territorial government is making to the governors of all of the states and to each member of Congress a copy of the "Bill of Rights," which was approved April 26. A letter requesting and in obtaining the recognition sought accompanies each copy.

The bill contains 16 printed pages, reviews the history of the island from 1852, when annexation to the United States was considered for the first time, until the present day.

"This declaration and its method of promulgation are extraordinary, unique in the history of legislation," the document says. "The reason for this procedure is that an extraordinary and critical situation faces Hawaii—one unique in history."

Legal Status is Declared

"For a quarter of a century Hawaii has occupied the legal status of full and complete political union with the United States as an integral part thereof, but a misunderstanding appears to exist in the congress and in some of the executive departments of the federal government as to the status, which has at times resulted in Hawaii as if it were an 'insular possession' in a derogatory manner to the dignity of this territory."

The document declares that "Hawaii is in no sense the 'property' of the United States, inasmuch as Hawaii became a part of the union by voluntary agreement as an independent nation, having sovereign powers co-equal with those of the United States. By the manner of its entrance 'Hawaii acquired certain inalienable rights, contractual, equitable and moral, to the maintenance of which the good faith of the United States is pledged," the measure asserts.

Senator Borah Urges Immediate Recognition of Russia

PROPER AND RIGHT THING TO DO, SAYS SENATOR

No Peace Possible in Europe While 140,000,000 People Outlawed, Given as Reason

WALLACE, Ida., Aug. 11.—Immediate recognition of the present government of Russia was described as the "proper thing, right thing and Christian thing to do," by Senator William E. Borah in an address at the annual miners' and smelters' picnic at Kellogg today.

Two great problems, Senator Borah said, he intended to discuss: The expenditure of the national revenue and marketing of the vast crops with which the country had been blessed. Associated with these problems is the even bigger problem of opening the world to the products of the United States, he continued.

"Despite the reports of the metropolitan press," said Senator Borah, "I am not a bolshevik. Bolshevism is not a creed, it is not a government, it is a disease."

"No peace is possible in Europe," he continued, "as long as 140,000,000 people are outlawed. Recognition of the government does not imply endorsement of the acts of that government. During the 16 years I have been in public life I have come in contact with every kind and form of organized lie, but never have I run up against a more finished product than that circulated about conditions in Russia."

France Rejoices Over News

PARIS, Aug. 11.—News received by the foreign office from Berlin indicating the early downfall of the Cuno cabinet and prospects of the formation of a government disposed to direct negotiations with France is being followed with great interest in French circles.

France, it appears from information gleaned at the foreign office, is quite willing and ready to talk, but it is pointed out that France cannot enter into negotiations with Germany on her own account alone.
