

## POST OFFICE ALERT TO PROTECT AGAINST FRAUD

Attention on Swindlers Saves

THE CASE IS MENTIONED

WASHINGTON, Aug. 18.—The United States government has issued a warning to its citizens to be on their guard against swindlers who are using the name of the post office to defraud them.

The warning is in the form of a circular letter which is being sent to all post offices in the United States. It is headed "Beware of Swindlers" and contains the following text:

"The United States post office is a government institution and is not a place where anyone can make money. No one is allowed to sell anything in the post office, and no one is allowed to buy anything from the post office. If you see anyone who is trying to sell you something in the post office, or if you see anyone who is trying to buy something from the post office, please report it to the nearest post office official. If you are sure that the person is a swindler, please report it to the nearest post office official.
