PORTLAND, Ore., Aug. 29.—Managers of creameries in all parts of the state are being asked today in a letter sent out by C. L. Hawley, dairy and food commissioner, to approve the plan for grading and buying cream, which was adopted at the creamery men's meeting in Portland last Wednesday.

BUTTER MARKET IS STEADY
In face of the advance in butter on the Seattle market and 1-2c advance at San Francisco, the local butter is steady and the purchaser is to pay for it 4c less from April 1 to October 1, and 2c less from October 1 to April 1. The above grading rules are to become effective on or before October 1.
