Prince Christian of Hesse Dines With King George and Queen Mary; Women Bell Ringers of England

LONDON.—Prince Christian of Hesse dined with King George and Queen Mary recently, thus giving the answer to the question which has been raised often since the war, as to who would be the first individual of German origin to be entertained at Buckingham palace after the close of hostilities.

Prince Christian came to London to attend the funeral of Queen Mother Alexandra, "Aunt Alex," he called her.

Early in the war he attracted public notice by writing an open letter to Kaiser Wilhelm at the beginning of the submarine campaign in the German navy as a protest.

NEW YORK.—Is your health worth the price of a half pound of candy? This is about the annual cost to each person of our city health departments, according to a report to be issued by the American Child Health Association.
