Fallacy of Popular Notion That Good Health Radiates From Undue Exposure to the Winter's Wet and Cold

A few weeks ago I took a drive with a successful doctor, a long-time friend of mine. It happened to be one of the first cold days at the beginning of winter.

My doctor friend growled: "Well, we'll be zero never again now a day in the healthfulness of cold, muggy weather. Most folks hold to the idea that such weather is good for us and that we thrive as a consequence of it."

One reason I dread the cold because the houses go cold. It is just as easy to get a terrible cold indoors as out in the weather.

Lots of persons, women particularly, have naturally cold feet—that is, they feel cold to the touch. But I do not refer to coldness of this degree.

One of the foolish ideas of too many persons is to be ashamed of warm stockings or warm shoes. It is all right to wear sheer, silk stockings if your duties do not keep you out-of-doors, or in a cold house hours at a time.

Indoor workers who spend but a little while each day in the cold out-of-doors should have heavy overcoats or wraps, and other means of protection against that terrible chilling which cuts to the bone.

Please don't go to the other extreme and get no fresh air at all. That is even worse than the chilling. You need the oxygen just as much as in the summer—more in deed.
