LANE FARMERS ENDORSE SHUMWAY FOR SENATOR
C. W. Allen of Vida Named President of Union
STATE OFFICERS VISIT
Co-operation Asked From Linn County in Fighting Canada Tinsite Sausage in Valley
(Register Lane County Special)
SPRINGFIELD, Ore., Jan. 22.—A. R. Shumway of Milton, candidate for nomination for United States senator, was endorsed by the Lane County Farmers' Union at its annual meeting in Springfield today. A resolution to that effect was passed by the group and placed on the records.
The resolution follows:
"Whereas, A. R. Shumway of Milton, Oregon, has announced his candidacy for the nomination for United States Senator.
"Therefore, be it resolved that the Lane County Farmers' Union in its annual meeting of the 22nd day of January, 1926, do on record, unqualifiedly and enthusiastically endorse Mr. Shumway's candidacy, knowing him to be well qualified by education and experience and a man who will not only serve the best interests of the farmer, but the best interests of the state of Oregon."
C. W. Allen of Vida was elected president of the county union, to succeed R. P. Laird, who held the office for three years. W. J. Seales of Eugene was elected vice-president; Mrs. George Kappauf of Cottage Grove, secretary-treasurer; Walter Morgan of Creswell, conductor; H. H. Smith of Eugene, bookkeeper; O. L. Clemens of Wallowville, chaplain.
The elected officers were installed in office by Mr. Shumway, a member of the state board of the Farmers' Union. Other state officers present were Herbert Egbert of The Dalles, president, and Mrs. George B. Jones of Monmouth, secretary. Five Oregon counties were represented at the meeting and A. D. Rice, who is visiting in the West for a time, represented the Kansas state union.
No committees were named by President Allen today. He will make appointments on the various committees for the year within the next few days.
