
BEAR TRADERS CARRY ON

ANOTHER SWEEPING REACTION IN STOCK MARKET

NEW YORK, N. Y., June 12.—(AP)—Heavy liquidation of impaired marginal accounts coupled with the savage attacks of bear traders brought about another sweeping reaction in today's stock market.

Radio, which had resisted most of the selling attacks of the past week, finally yielded to selling pressure and ran off 23 points to 166½, rebounding to 171 at the close. Wright Aeronautical fell from 155 to 142; Curtiss from 101 to 90; Green Cananea Copper from 107½ to 90, and Rossia Insurance from 175 to 160, with final quotations generally around the day's lows.
