First Post Offices in Maine.

In 1775 the first post offices in Maine were established at Kennebunk, Falmouth and Bath. The mails were carried by carriers on foot or on horseback and the average week's mail did not amount to five letters at each office. The rates were high, 6 1/4, 12 1/2, 18 3/4, 25 and 37 1/2 cents, according to the distance the letter had to be carried, and double the rate when the letter was one more than one sheet of paper.

It is probable that the coloring of glass, and particularly the garnet tint and not the ruby hue, as some authorities would have us believe, originated in Bohemia. This color—garnet—is obtained by alloying or fusing an extremely minute quantity of gold with the other ingredients—silica, soda, lime, iron oxide and alumina. On its first heating the glass is colorless, but on reheating it develops its soft, rich appearance.—New York World.

Questionnaires sent to the graduates of the Harvard medical and law schools brought out the fact that the average physician earns \$554 in his first year of practice, about \$1,000 in his second year, about \$2,000 in his fifth year and nearly \$5,000 by his thirtieth year, and that the average lawyer earns \$664 in his first year, \$1,110 in his second year, \$2,668 in his fifth year, \$4,426 in his eighth year and \$6,825 in his tenth year of practice.
