



Shipments containing eggs which have volks stuck to the shell, moldy eggs, black spots, mixed rots, addled eggs, and any other eggs which are filthy, decomposed or putrid, are in violation of the law.

Careful candling before shipment will enable dealers to eliminate the bad eggs. The elimination of the spoiled or partially spoiled eggs before shipment not only removes the hazard of violating federal and state




