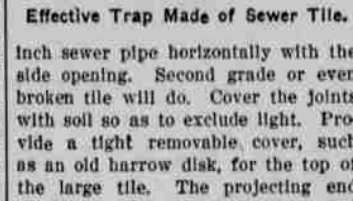
## Horticultural Facts

### TILE TRAP FOR COTTONTAILS

Inexpensive and Permanent Contrivance Described in Farmer's Bulletin No. 702.

An inexpensive and permanent sewer tile trap for cottontail rabbits, which has proved very effective in Kansas, is described in Farmer's Bulletin 702, "Cottontail Rabbits in Relation to Trees and Farm Crops." Details of this trap were supplied by Mr. J. M. Walmisty, who has used it successfully on his and other farms in that state. To make the trap, proceed as follows:

Set a 12 by 6-inch "tee" sewer tile with the long end downward, and bury it so that the six-inch opening at the side is below the surface of the ground. Connect two lengths of six-

inch sewer pipe horizontally with the side opening. Second grade or even broken tile will do. Cover the joints with soil so as to exclude light. Provide a tight removable cover, such as an old harrow disk, for the top of the large tile. The projecting end of the small tile is then surrounded with rocks, brush or wood so as to make the hole look inviting to rabbits and to encourage them to frequent the den. Rabbits, of course, are free to go in and out of these dens, which should be constructed in promising spots on the farm and in the orchard. A trained dog will locate inhabited dens. The outlet is closed with a disk of wood on a stake, or the dog guards the opening. The cover is lifted and the rabbits captured by hand.

These traps are especially suitable for open lands and prairies, where rabbits cannot find natural hiding places. They are permanent and cost nothing for repairs from year to year. If it is desired to poison rabbits, the baits may be placed inside these traps, out of the way of domestic animals or birds. This trap also furnishes an excellent means of obtaining rabbits for the table, or even for market.

### BEST TIME TO PRUNE TREES

Spring Season is Best Time, Although Work May Be Performed Any Time Without Much Injury.

The best time to prune fruit trees is in the spring, although they may be pruned at any time without serious injury. Two main objects of pruning apple and plum trees are to make trees which will not break down easily and will bear good crops of well-colored fruit. When young trees are planted the main branches are reduced to from three to five, arranged in such a manner that there will not be bad crotches formed by any two branches. Afterwards cross branches are removed each year. Severe pruning in any one year is not desirable. If the trees you desire to prune are not young trees the plan is to prune away branches which cross others, and if the tree seems very thick to remove some additional branches, but it is often better to cut away some of the smaller branches from the outside of the tree rather than to cut out large branches, the wounds of which take a long time to heal over. It is not necessary to put anything on the wounds where they are less than, say, about an inch in diameter; but it is desirable to keep larger wounds painted with white lead paint.

### SETTING OUT APPLE ORCHARD

Select Varieties Best Suited to Locality by Watching Neighbor's Trees—Point of Big Importance.

No point is more important in the setting of the commercial orchard than the selection of varieties. As the thrift, bearing habits and quality of the fruit depend largely upon the local climatic conditions these should be carefully studied before the selection is made.

Watch how a certain variety behaves in your neighbor's orchard. This will give you an idea of its adaptability to your locality. Nearly all the desirable commercial varieties are in bearing in all localities, and can thus be readily observed. However there are a few varieties demanded by market which do well generally in certain localities.

### REJECT ANY DEFORMED TREE

Knots or Swellings on Roots are Usually Caused by Crown Gall—Trim Off the Tops.

Do not accept trees that show knots or swellings on the roots or at the union of root and scion. Such knots are usually caused by crown gall. Do not fail to trim back the tops to correspond with the roots. The top growth should never be too strong for the roots to support it. Do not order trees too large; two years is old enough. Trim off all broken or injured branches and roots; they are simply damage to the trees.
