CLEANLY SHAVING STICK. Arrangement Which Pre

Shaving sticks, as at present manufactured, are cyllndrical in shape and are sold in cylindrical casing of cardboard or other suitable material. In using the stick it is commonly re-

A Philadelphia inventor proposes to overcome these objection y providing a ring made of metal, cr other suitable material, that has an dge adapted to bite into the soap Whlle its outer edge clamps the inner thereln. By this construction the fin gers are nelther made sticky nor does of the casing. The metal clamping ring is made with a break in the outer edge, this constituting a spring clamp. The inside of the ring is provided with reeth adapted to engage in the soap stick, holding it securely. It will be understood, as the soap stick is worn off by use, the clamping ring must be
moved toward its unused end. The ring not only affords a conventent grasp, but prevents the molsture from etting Inside the casing. An arrangement similar to the ordinary apring controlled candle lamp, but modied the soap stick top, might also be worked soap
out.
