INDUSTRIAL PAYROLLS

Estacada and Adjacent Industries Which Help In Building Up the City

Very little has been said about the various manufacturing and other industries of Estacada and immediate vicinity. These industrial businesses add a great deal to the commercial life of Estacada and are important factors in the development of the city and country. The companies doing the largest amount of work and having the biggest payrolls are:

The Estacada Brick & Tile Company, whose plant in Estacada is one of the best west of the Rockies, has a monthly payroll of over \$900. This company is now making fine, pressed brick. Later they expect to make tile, pottery etc.

The Estacada Wood Manufacturing Company which, when running a full crew, pays out over \$1,000 a month to its employes.

The Dubois Lumber Company of Estacada, whose mill near town is always busy turning out lumber in all makes, pays its help over \$700

a month.

Another lumber concern which pays over \$1,000 a month is the Estacada Lumber Company, which is always rushed with orders.

T. Vocum & Sons are now installing a sawmill on their place and will have a payroll of \$500 or \$600.

The Oregon Water Power & Railway Company, in its development and construction work at Cazadero, has a monthly payroll of something like \$10,000.

Much of the money paid out by these companies pass through Estacada business houses. Last month over \$1,800.00 was paid out by the Estacada State Bank on monthly time checks of the O. W. P. & Ry. Co. The business of these industries is increasing, and as the attention of the prospective business man is called to our possibilities the manufacturing industries will increase in number.
