

WATER QUESTION IS DISCUSSTD

Another meeting for discussing the water question and other immaterial matters was had by the people of Estacada, Tuesday evening. After the election of a chairman and secretary, the report of the committee elected two weeks ago was heard and accepted. This committee reported that the present water system is worth \$4,882. A motion by Mr. Heylman that in view of the report of the committee the city refuse to buy the water works brought on the discussion. This was participated in by Messrs. Stratton, Heylman, Morrow, Boswell and Gilstrap and a vote on the proposition resulted in 14 against buying the system and 26 in favor of it. The chairman and secretary were elected to convey the meeting's decision to the city council, and the meeting adjourned. W. P. Keady was present and elucidated on what the water system consists of. At the close of the popular meeting the council convened and immediately adjourned until 8 p. m. Saturday.
