NEW DISCOVERIES OF RICH BRICK CLAY DEPOSITS

Clay From These Beds Has Been Tested and Found to Be Very Valuable

The clays will make a firstclass fire brick, a vitrified brick, and buff, white and cream brick. The grade of vitrified brick made is the best, these are

used for street paving, sewer and drainage pipes. From the Buff, white and cream colored brick can be made a beautiful enameled, facing brick.
