Helene Paulson's Funeral

The funeral of Miss Helen Paulson, eldest daughter of Mr. and Mrs. H. Paulson of George, took place from the family residence, on Sunday Sept. 23. Services were held at the house by Rev. A. W. Reinhard in both the German and English languages, after which a large concourse of relatives and friends followed the remains to the grave at the George cemetery. Flowers in abundance covered the grave. Miss Paulson was born June 20, 1882 at George, and lived there until five years ago. She had been living at her brothers' home at Portland. She took sick six weeks ago with typhoid pneumonia and died on the 20th. Besides her parents two sisters and three brothers mourn her death. Miss Paulson was a member of the Fourth Presbyterian church of Portland, and of the United Artisan lodge.
