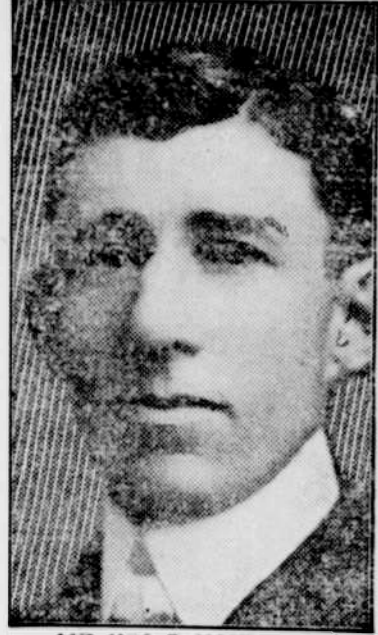

TORNADO BRINGS DEATH AND HAVOC

Thirty Known Dead and Many Injured in Arkansas.

Two Twisters Start at Same Time and Sweep Path Four Miles Wide - Crops and Forests Levelled to Ground - Several Towns Almost Demolished.

Little Rock, Ark., Nov. 24.—Two tornadoes, one north and the other south bound, swept over West Arkansas yesterday afternoon destroying many lives and much property.

One tornado started in the extreme southwestern part of the state and traveled northward following the second tier of counties from the western boundary line.

The counties through which the tornado passed are Lafayette, Columbia, Miller, Pike, Howard, Hempstead, Montgomery, Yell, Pope, Johnson, Franklin and Carroll.

According to advices received, the storm was at its height when it swept through Piney, a German settlement on the Iron Mountain railroad, between Knoxville and London.
