Washington's birthday was celebrated in Portland by the planting of rose bushes in the parks and public squares of the city with appropriate exercises. Thousands of bushes were set out throughout the city and the new plants will be blooming in time for the annual rose festival in June. City and state officers, together with repres ntatives of foreign nations that contributed their native roses for the affair, participated in the rose planting exercises. This has become an annual event in Portland and the custom is growing in favor each year. The new packing plant of the Swift interests on the Peninsula is expected to start operations on March 14.
