"The Beaver" and "The Bear" are twin vessels, modern and luxurious in the extreme. Last Thursday "The Bear" had a "boat-warming" at Portland, and from two o'clock in the afternoon until nine in the evening entertained hundreds of visitors.

Most interesting single feature of all was the award of contract for a ning. Ist class work mammoth bridge over the Columbia at Celilo Falls for the Oregon Trunk. The cost will be approximately \$1,500,000, there will be twenty-nine spans to the structure and it must be completed by January 1, 1912. The total length is 3960 feet, or more than threequarters of a mile. The longest span is 350 feet.


