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
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



#### United Wireless Officers Arrested for Huge Frauds.

We despise a man who doesn't ap- Postal Inspector Says Officials of Company Sold Stock for Thousand Times Its Value.

> New York, N. Y .- United States postoffice inspectors raided the handsome Broadway offices of the United Wireless Telegraph company today and caused the arrest of Christopher C. Wilson, president of the company; Samuel S. Bogart, first vice-president, and William W. Tompkins, president of the New York selling agency, which, officers of the wireless company say, was formerly their fiscal agent, but has ceased to represent them.

Chief Inspector Mayer subsequently gave out a statement, in which he charges that, although the company has been running at a loss, the price of its shares have advanced by manipula-tion to fictitious values and that indience course. As though everyone does vidual officers of the company have sold out their stock to the general public at a profit estimated in one instance at between \$5,000,000 and \$10,000,000.

Wilson was released on \$25,000 bail and Bogart on \$10,000 bail for appearance on July 12, when a further hearing will be held before a Federal commissioner.

Tompkins was arrested at his farm near Mahop Falls, Pa., and brought here. He could not find \$10,000 and spent the night in the Tombs.

The specified instance of 'alleged fraudulent use of the mails is given as the mailing of a letter on March 3, 1910, to Michael O'Brien, of Waterburg, Conn. "There are 28,000 shareholders of
