LARGELY MATTER OF FAITH
Proof of Authenticity of Relics, Religious or Historical, in Most Cases Impossible.
The authenticity of relics, religious or historical, must in many cases be largely a matter of faith; proof is often lacking, often indeed impossible to procure. The number of couches notable from the fact "that they have been slept in by good Queen Bess" shows in many hours of a legion and the same may be said of many other historical heirlooms the real history of which is lost in the mists of antiquity. How many pairs of gloves were given by King Charles I. as keepsakes on the day of his execution? There are quite a number of claimants for the honor. One pair has recently been the cause of a law suit, and it was said in the course of the trial that they were given by the king to Bishop Juxon on the scaffold. There is yet another pair which has had a far stranger history than most Stuart relics, which have indeed little history, but a quiet passing from generation to generation in English country houses. They were sent by King Charles on the day of execution by a trusty hand to Speaker Lenthall "for family's sake." Only one of the pair now survives, the other was buried in a bush fire in Australia. The precious gloves had gone there when the Lenthalls awhile ago left their homes and their lands and had, with Charles II.'s pardon of Lenthall, been cherished in many wanderings in Australia. The surviving glove and the pardon are now back in England, because happily the Lenthalls are back. It is quite likely that King Charles gave away several pairs of gloves, for gloves then were costly things—ettes gave them to visiting sovereigns where now addresses or gold boxes are given. But in the days of the Stuarts gloves were costly enough at any rate to carry a sentiment, even a king's sentiment.

OLD AGE IS INEXORABLE
Men Find It Out When They Attempt to Frisk About in Boy Fashion.
If you ever doubt that you're growing old and sedate, you fathers, just take the kids out into the woods and see the difference between yourself of today and yesterday. You see them plunging about with whoops of joy, and generally living gladly. And you—well, when you try to sit down your knees creak, and the leaves beneath you don't seem as they once did. It would be beneath your dignity, but something within you seems calling to you, and your old body can't respond. You want to yell and run—that is, you believe you do, but it's no use. Something is holding you back. So there you sit and watch the children playing, and their happiness is as once yours was. And it makes the heart ache to think of it—some day they will be even as you—longing to break loose into joy born of the autumn, but held back. Held back by something that we call old age.

WAR OVER CRETE IS THREAT.
New York Greeks Ask Taft to Help Keep Isle From Turkey.
New York.—That an effort on the part of the Ottoman Empire to coerce the Greeks would result in another revolution was the subject of a mass meeting of the Greek colony. The meeting was convoked by the Pan-Hellenic Union, representing 8000 Greeks in the vicinity of New York, to protest against the alleged intention of European powers to hand over the island of Crete to Turkey. The meeting adopted resolutions calling upon President Taft and Congress to oppose an effort to subject the island to Turkish sovereignty and asked that the President remind the powers that the interests of peace demand that Crete be incorporated with the Kingdom of Greece.

Bubonic Plague Spreads.
Pekin.—A number of deaths from bubonic plague have occurred in this city since the first death from the disease here was reported Saturday. The region staffs are quarantining themselves within their own walls, having been unable to agree on general measures for the entire legation. Advice from Chefu state that the epidemic has been carried across the Gulf of Pechili in junk and that it will extend throughout Northern China and Corea.

Vote Buying Confession.
Danville, Ill.—Election corruption and bribery which is declared to have been rampant for years in "Uncle Joe" Cannon's hallowed Vermillion county, promises to be bared to the grand jury investigating a statement sent to a newspaper by a prominent attorney in which he confessed buying votes in a previous election. The attorney in his statement says he kept records of the names of the vote sellers and the amounts given them but this record, he said, he recently burned.

New Shipping Law Prohibitive.
London.—Asserting that owners of British ships will be unable to send their vessels to sea in time of war if parliament ratifies the "declaration of London," an agreement adopted two years ago by the chief naval powers governing war prizes, Lloyd's came out in opposition to sanctioning the plan. Lloyd's asserts that if the declaration is finally confirmed and accepted the war risk on merchantmen will be prohibitive.

Refugees Flee From Harbin.
Kalam Cheng Tze, China.—Plague refugees from Harbin are arriving here in great numbers. The fatalities increase daily. The Japanese are erecting plague camps capable of containing 4000.

REBEL SHIP TAKEN
Cruiser Tacoma Puts Forces on Revolutionary Craft.
President Bonilla Gives Americans Free Rein in Preventing Bombardment of Ports.

Washington, Jan. 23.—The report that the Hornet, General Bonilla's revolutionary gunboat, which has been promoting his cause along the coast of Honduras, has been boarded by a force from the American gunboat Tacoma was confirmed in a wireless dispatch received by the navy department today from Commander Cooper of the United States steamship Marietta. The dispatch merely said it had been found necessary to place a force on board to detain the Hornet, and added that details would be reported later. The state department is awaiting information to determine its future course.

The attorney-general is investigating whether the Hornet has violated the neutrality laws of the United States, and pending the result the state department has announced that the vessel would not be permitted to commit any act of hostility against Honduras.

The action of Commander Davis of the Tacoma, in boarding the Hornet, it is assumed here, was based on an intention of the revolutionists to strike a telling blow. The naval officers in Honduras waters were given considerable latitude in carrying out their instructions to prevent an assault by the Hornet.

The Hornet sailed from New Orleans, ostensibly for Cape Gracias, on the northeastern coast of Nicaragua. It has not been established where the vessel received her armaments. The Hornet was immediately transferred from American to Honduran registry and raised the Honduran flag, but the Honduran papers were issued by the Bonilla appointees. The validity of these papers is one of the questions being looked into. Officials here generally regard them as irregular.

RAISE IN TARIFFS URGED.
Railroad Official Says Rates Not Increased on Par With Prices.
Worcester, Mass.—Unless the railroads of the country charge higher rates for carrying freight, wages will have to be cut, according to arguments put forth by speakers at the meeting of the New England members of the American Railroad Employers' and Investors' Association here.
