Officials of the Oregon Develop- HIDES ment League, who had worked for the passage of the bill providing for a state immigration commissioner, were non-plussed when Governor West announced last week he would veto the measure. They succeeded, however, in inducing him to change his mind by waiving any claim to the \$25,000 appropriation the bill earried, so that the law will give the state the benefit of the United States Immigration Bureau work in placing desirable immigrants on the Oregon lands.

Lacking the necessary appropriation to carry on the work, public spirited citizens of Portland will shoulder the expense. The passage of the law will at least provide for state indorsement of promotion literature that shall be issued to attract immigration and this will make this matter authorative so it will carry more weight and at the same time guard against boomer matter. This will be for the benefit of the whole state and not any section alone. A state book, showing Oregon's advantages, will be issued under the seal of the new commissioner.
