
EYE NOT PATRIOTIC ENOUGH Oculist's Second Attempt Procures for Him Decoration From Haitien Emperor.



FLOATING ISLAND FOUND Queer Discovery Made by the Crew

of the Bark Atlas in the Pacific Ocean.

The crew of the bark Atlas, which arrived in Seattle recently after rounding the Horn from Philadelphia, reports a queer discovery for one day of the 138 of her voyage. 




