"Oregon should be deeply interested in this convention," said Mr. Richardson. "If Oregon could secure one per cent of the people of the congested cities of the East who should move, it would more than double the population of the state. The old East has no patriotism. The people talk about, travel in, and know only Europe and other far countries, and European travel drains this country of \$400,000,000 every year. Every community in the West should strive to make this convention one of the greatest ever held. We must arrest foreign sentiment and at least make our national capital an American city."
