Cleaning Bagdad Rugs.

It is very difficult to wash a Bagdad souch cover or rug successfully. The colors are almost sure to run when treated in the ordinary way. Before beginning operations separate the strips. Then wash each one in a separate water. Use white soap and lukewarm water to which a little sait has been added after a suds has been raised by brisk stirring. Do not rub the strips on a washboard, but merely dip them into the water and stir them brickly, then quickly rinse them and hang them over a clothes horse in the kitchen away from the sunlight. Be preful when drying that the strip o not overlap. When almost dry press out the wrinkles with a hot iron. If the middle strips have become slightly worn exchange them with those on the outside, when sewing the cover together again.
