Simple Refreshments Easily Prepared Without Spending Much Money or Effort.

When girl friends drop in unexpectdly for the evening dainty refreshments add much to the pleasure of the guests without causing any great exenditure of either money or effort. Hot chocolate is a favorite beverage of all womankind and the truly hospitable woman is always an adept at making it.

To make hot chocolate allow one quince of chocolate to each pint of liquid. To make one quart put two ounces of chocolate in a double boller with one pint of hot water. Stir until the chocolate is melted, then add one pint of rich milk. Beat and stir rapidly until it boils again. Add three tablespoonfuls of sugar, take from the fire and beat quickly. Have the chocolate pot hot when the chocolate is turned in and served with whipped cream. If slightly thickened chocolate is desired make a thin paste of two teaspoonfuls of cornstarch moistened with milk and stir slowly into the mixture just before it is taken from the stove.


Dainty sandwiches to serve with the chocolate are made by cutting white bread into thin slices and spreading them with a paste made of finely chopped pecan nut meats and mayonnaise. Lettuce sandwiches have a leaf of crisp lettuce spread with the mayonnaise as filling. Butter the bread before using the filling. Some hostesses keep a jar of chopped nuts or peanut butter on hand all the time and so are never at a loss when the unexpected guest drops in. Peanut sandwiches are made by spreading one slice of the bread thinly with butter and the other with the peanut butter. Put together with a lettuce leaf.

SHELL 400,000 YEARS OLD.

Fossil Preserves Color Tortoise Through Ages.

Los Angeles, Cal.—Three thousand feet above sea level on the slopes of lon picked up the perfect fossil of a huge sea tortoise, which Hector Alliot, curator of the Southwest museum, pronounces the most important discovery of the kind ever made in uthern California.

Donlon has a bee ranch and was a hive when he saw the shell protruding from the ground. The stone weighs 100 pounds and shows the exact markings and some of the original color on the back and yellow bottom. The specimen is nearly 30 inches in liameter.

Alliot estimates that it is 400,000 years old, the most ancient specimen ever picked up on the Western hemisphere. The tortoise swam in these seas, he says, when California and all the territory this side of the Rocky mountains was still a mile or two under water.

Madero to Disband Army

Puebla, Mex.-Professing surprise at the many Maderistas he finds yet bearing arms, and realizing the danger of maintaining an undisciplined army in time of peace, Francisco I. Madero has determined upon a policy of immediate disarmament. He said the work of mustering out revolutionary forces would be started at once until Mexico has but one army. It is believed that the battle in Pucbla was started by young men of the town firng on the barracks of both armies.

Haytians Take Valleire. Port Au Prince, Hayti-The government troops under General Glemen-ceau have occupied Valliere without a fight, the insurgents retiring. Groups of rebels are now directing their attention to points where the government troops have been weakened. Two divisions have been sent against Hiniche, a small town held by insurgents. By order of the Cape Haytien authorities the light at Picolet Point has been extinguished. This has given rise to protests as a measure dangerous to navigation.
