Governor West will make his second appearance at the Astoria Centennial Pageant on August 17, the day set aside for Salem, southern Oregon and the Willamette Valley at the big historical celebration. He is to make a speech on this day and will have the mayors of the cities through the Willamette Valley on the big Stadium platform with him.

Special excursions are to be run from all Willamette Valley points at reduced rates for this day. At the same time there will be in session the great Oregon Development League which has its closing session on Salem and Willamette Valley Day.

The entertainment provided for this day includes a performance by Ellery's Royal Italian Band both afternoon and evening, scientific kite flying in the afternoon and Indian War Dances by the Indians from the Yakima Reservation.

Numerous short one hour and two hour water trips are provided for those who wish to take them and the steamer Carlos will take all who wish to make the trip for a ride out beyond the jetty into the Pacific Ocean.

Those who desire to may remain over for the big Panama-Pacific Day celebration on August 18 when all the big guns from California will be in attendance coming by special train right up from the Willamette Valley. On this night there will be a big spectacular parade "The Golden West" which is said to be planned to rival the big electrical parade at the Rose Festival.

Big delegations from all parts of the state will gather at Astoria for the annual convention of the Oregon Development League on August 14, 15 and 16. There is wide interest in the approaching session and a splendid program has been arranged. Each section promises to have a full representation and the meeting will mark a forward step in development circles.

The Centennial Celebration will have an added interest for delegates to the League gathering and Astoria, known far and wide for its hospitality, will make a special effort to entertain the Leaguers. On the whole, the approaching convention promises to be the best ever held in the history of the state-wide development body.

Lakeview people are making arrangements for a monster celebration in October when the new railroad, now building north from California, will reach that city. It is proposed to have the biggest demonstration of the kind ever held in Interior Oregon, and it is expected that other cities of South Central Oregon will participate. It is probable there will be a week of general rejoicing over the arrival of the railroad.

Oregon's hop crop is another source of prosperity for the farmer this season. With 30 cents already paid for the growing crop and reports of extreme shortage abroad, making further advances likely, the hop grower is in high feather. The state has an excellent yield of hops this season, the total being estimated at 100,000 bales, which is the biggest crop since 1907.

Springfield, after a big fire that wiped out the principal industry of the city, is going ahead planning a carnival, to be held late this month. The Springfield spirit is not easily discouraged and a bigger and busier city will be built because of this indomitable quality.

**May Close Hunting Season**  
New Forest Fire Law Gives Governor Power to Close Hunting Season

The open season for hunting deer as well as a number of other animals and game birds, began August 1, and State Forester F. A. Elliott has his ear to the ground for reports of forest fires started through the carelessness of hunters. Every year a great many fires are caused by sportsmen leaving their campfires unextinguished, and thoughtlessly dropping lighted matches, cigars and cigarettes as they travel through the forest in pursuit of game.  
It will probably be news to many people of Oregon to learn that the Forest Fire Law, which went into effect February 24, empowers the Governor to declare a closed season for the shooting of wild birds and animals of any kind. The law covering this point is as follows:—  
"Whenever, or wherever, during an open season for the hunting of any kind of game in this State, it shall appear to the Governor upon the showing of the State Forester that by reason of extreme drought the use of firearms or fire by hunters is liable to cause forest fires, he may, by proclamation, suspend the open season and make it a closed season for the shooting of wild birds and animals of any kind for such time as he may designate, and during the time so designated all provisions of law regulating to closed seasons for game shall be in force."  
"It is, of course, not my intention to urge the enforcement of this provision unless it becomes absolutely necessary in order to prevent destruction of forest property," said Forester Elliott in commenting upon the extract. "Whether any action is taken depends entirely upon the behavior of the hunters themselves. However, just as soon as this office receives reports that fires are being started through the carelessness of hunters, I shall immediately present the facts to the Governor and recommend that a closed season be proclaimed. The Governor is heartily in favor of this plan and has assured me that he stands ready to issue such proclamation should conditions warrant it. This matter, as I see it, is entirely in the hands of the hunters, for as long as they exercise due precaution while in the forests I will, of course, have no reason for taking action. It would be an excellent plan for every hunter to familiarize himself with the Oregon Forest Fire Law, copies of which will be sent upon application to this office."
