TURN DOWN BUILDING

Voters Decide against Domestic Science Addition

VOTE IS 5 TO 1 AGAINST IT

Taxpayers Averse to Spending More Money at Present—Athletics at a Standstill Until Next Spring

By a vote of 50 to 11, the voters of Estacada school district decided against constructing, at this time, a building to house the domestic science and manual training departments, suggested as likely to be added to the course at the High school next year.

The matter was brought up sooner than expected because of the burning of the Estacada Pavilion, which left the athletic department of the school, without a floor on which to play basketball. The voters, however, were strongly of the opinion that further expenditure, at this time, is ill advised.

There were a number of speakers for and against the proposition. Principal B. F. Ford outlining the necessity for additional room and submitting an estimate of \$700 for the building. Prof. Guthrie told of the movement to have state appropriations for schools which have the manual training and domestic science departments and took occasion to compliment the district for the advanced position it had in the state. Dr. Adix added a word of encouragement for the building, as did W. F. Carey and G. J. Kelly, real estate manager for the P. R. L. & P. Co. who happened to be present. J. W. Reed thought the building would be alright if the district could afford it.

The principal speaker against the building was E. S. Womer who, in endorsing athletics to some extent, thought a small town didn't need them as badly as a city. His idea was that children could apply their education at home after school by doing chores and manipulating a potato digger. Mrs. O. O. Bland thought the district was going too fast. She said she was proud of the school and believed it did excellent work.

Chairman Woodie appointed tellers and judges, F. J. Harkender, H. M. James and Edwin Bates, who collected the votes and announced the result. Athletics and especially basketball will be at a standstill for the winter.

Shearer Wins Silver Cup

Ed Shearer of Garfield, Estacada's chicken fancier, won the \$25 cup for the best bird typical of its breed, shown at the Portland Poultry Show last week. The bird was a light Brahma pullet.

Mr. Shearer's capons also received a prize. The pair weighed 25 pounds. His other exhibits received favorable mention and altogether his ranch received a lot of excellent advertising. Mr. Shearer's fame has reached the eastern states and for perhaps the first time in the history of this section of the state, he is shipping chickens east. Formerly it was the other way around. The blooded birds were brought out from the east.

Cost of Lateral Sewers

William Kuhrasch, J. V. Barr and W. D. Henthorn, board of appraisers for the newly established sewer district completed their survey and estimate for the improvement and figure the cost per lot is 35 cents a front foot, or \$8.75 per lot. The total amount to be laid includes about a block in the alley between Zobrist and Broadway from Second street, a block between Main and Broadway and one in the alley between Main and Curriu from Second to opposite the school house.

The total cost is \$1503.55. The contract for construction will be awarded after bids have been submitted.

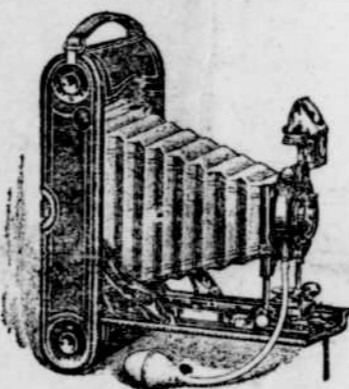
