



William Kuhrasch, J. V. Barr and W. D. Henthorn, board of appraisers for the newly established sewer district completed their survey and estimate for the improvement and figure the cost per lot is 35 cents a front foot, or \$8.75 per lot. The total amount to be laid includes about a block in the alley between Zobrist and Broadway from Second street, a block between Main and Broadway and one in the alley between Main and Currin from Second to opposite the school house.
