

New York-To test the validity of the Federal income tax act suit was filed in the United States District court here to restrain the Union Pacific railroad company from paying taxes under the new law. The petitioner, Frank R. Brushaver, of Brook-lyn, a stockholder, maintains the income tax is unconstitutional.

Mr. Brushaver contends the income tax law conflicts with the third clause of the second section of article one of the Federal constitution in that while it purports to be a tax on net income it is in fact a tax on the real and personal property in which the net re-ceipts of the Union .Pacific were invested and is a direct tax, and, therefore void.




