Where the Feed Went.

The United States department of agriculture took twenty cows and tried the effect of ticks on their milk yield They found that cows with a light "dose" of ticks gave about four-fifths as much milk as those with none, and cows heavily infested gave less than half as much. It took just as much work to care for the tick infested cows. and the ticks took over half of their
