In a letter to the Progress of  
 August 28th, Chairman Grant B.  
 Dimick of the County Fair Board  
 admits that to date his board has  
 heard nothing further from the  
 PROMISED \$400. from the coun-  
 ty court.

Continuing he says, "We have  
 been patiently waiting for the  
 court to instruct us what to do."

Probably past experience has  
 taught Mr. Dimick that "patient-  
 ly waiting" will net just as good  
 results, as raising a fuss, but it  
 is a dirty shame that something  
 cannot be done to wake up the  
 honorable county court to some  
 action.

The court is supposed to be a  
 servant of the people and not a  
 high tribunal which pays no re-  
 gard to the tax payers' wishes nor  
 makes good the promises extend-  
 ed.

Mr. Dimick admits that the  
 outlook for a Clackamas county  
 exhibit at the State Fair this  
 year, is a poor one, as there is no  
 one to take the initiative in gath-  
 ering exhibits and no money is to  
 be had.

Last year Clackamas county  
 was awarded the highest honors  
 at the State Fair, but this year  
 we will be lucky to be represent-  
 ed, thanks to the utter disregard  
 of the tax payers' wishes by the  
 members of the county court.

If the tax payers will stop  
 "Patiently Waiting" and join to-  
 gether, we can either get the  
 promised \$400. or get a new  
 county court.
