Interested Farmers Meet

About forty farmers from this vicinity attended the picnic meeting at the Garfield Country Club last Friday.

Owing to urgent work, many did not attend who had hoped to be able to hear the talks by Prof. Boquet and Dr. McPherson, on the raising of brocolli and the marketing of farm produce.

Among the visitors were two men from Oswego, who had learned of this meeting to consider the planting of brocolli and wished to obtain further information, although they are already growing the product.

Prof. Boquet pointed out the fact that only by planting in large enough acreage to guarantee carload lots, was it advisable for a community to attempt the culture of this vegetable. He also warned the growers against raising any but the finest of brocolli, calling attention to the strong competition from Roseburg, Or., California, Louisiana and Florida.

Similar meetings to discuss vital farming problems should be held often and the attendance will increase as their value becomes known.
