If the teeth are properly cared for they will not be injured by sweets.

Scottish crisps always tempt a child's appetite and are easily and quickly made: Beat one egg un-til light, add gradually one-half cupful of sugar then add twothirds tablespoon of melted butter, one cupful rolled oats, onethird teaspoon salt, one-fourth teaspoon vanilla.

Drop mixture by teaspoonfuls on thoroughly greased inverted dripping pan one inch apart bake in moderate oven until delicately browned. Remove from pan as soon as taken from oven, using case knife. Seeded raisins may be placed on top of the cakes or, one may use two-thirds cup oats and one-third cup shredded cocoa-
