"Resolved, that we, the Eastern Clackamas Taxpayers League, do heartily condemn the proposed purchase of the Canby Fair Grounds, by the County Court of Clackamas County, as recommended at the late Taxpayers Meeting, held in the Court House in Oregon City; believing that said meeting did not voice the wishes of the majority of the taxpayers of the county."
