Judge Ably Defends Court

Barton bridge and Damascus, into Portland.

Chairman Miller appointed the following committee to investigate the proposed routes and to report at the April meeting: J. W. Reed, of Estacada; J. P. Steinman and R. H. Currin, of Currinsville; Carl Hanson, of the Swede Settlement; W. R. Telford and John Meyer, of Boring; D. L. Erdman, H. F. Gibson and J. C. Miller, of Barton.

Bob Schuebel, of Canby, spoke for about half an hour on subjects more or less of vital importance to the league, but in many instances digressed into national and state matters, in which the audience was not overly interested.

Mr. Schuebel did call to the attention of the taxpayers many flagrant violations of the county's laws, among them being many due to the complex condition of Oregon's road laws.

The speaker urged the extension of the taxpayers' league movement, to include the entire county and for the purpose of organizing such a county league, invited all taxpayers to a meeting to be held at the Courthouse in Oregon City, on Tuesday, March 28th, next.

Mr. Schuebel strongly scored the Oregon City newspapers for the high rate charged for the advertising of the County Delinquent Tax Lists this year, as compared with former years and offered a solution based on mailing out said delinquent tax notices direct to the property owners.

Mr. S. Bowman, representing the Oregon City Enterprise, in answer to Mr. Schuebel's claims, ably defended the official newspapers in their charges for advertising, showing that the current list is almost double the size of last year's and based on a flat 5 cent per line rate, the same as is charged in many other counties.

Mr. Geo. Turner of Barton reported on the present status of the Barton gravel pit and on the recommendation of Judge Anderson it was decided to await the action of the court before agitating the matter further, as the judge said there were plans on foot which he hoped would end in opening up and operating the pit.

It was decided to hold the April meeting of the league at Barton hall, on Monday afternoon, April 17th.

It is hoped the next meeting will have on its program as speakers, the newly appointed county road engineer and road boss, Messrs. Cobb and Roots.

As soon as the weather moderates and the roads get into better shape, the summer meetings of the league will be held in Garfield, George, Springwater and other distant points from the railway.
