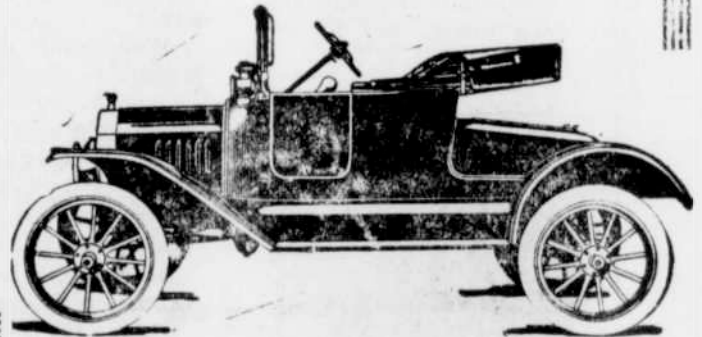

The School Library Contributed.

The library of the Grades and High School comprises about seven hundred books. From among these almost any taste in reading can be satisfied and, rightly used, they may prove a definite educational factor. There are books that will give knowledge, inspiration or relaxation to the reader. Among the former are works on travel, geology, nature, agriculture and, indeed, almost any subject of which knowledge may be desired.

Among the inspirational books, perhaps the biographies are the most noteworthy. The library contains biographies of many of the great men of our own and other countries. Most of these are so written as to make fascinating reading. The life of Alice Freeman Palmer, written by her husband is one of the sweetest love stories ever written.

In fiction we have masterpieces of the world's great authors as well as the lighter, more entertaining and more modern novels. Such books as Ben Hur, David Copperfield, The Last Days of Pompeii, etc. should be read by everyone at least once during their lifetime.

Our teachers' training library includes about fifty volumes of valuable treatises on educational subjects. They are of great help

to the young people who are fitting themselves to be teachers and may also be borrowed by teachers of surrounding schools.

In addition to the school library we also have a traveling library from the Oregon State Library which is changed every six months. The last library, of fifty volumes, which arrived recently is an unusually good collection. It contains "Septimus" by W. J. Locke, said by some to be the greatest novel ever written as well as other stories and books of travel, adventure, art, literature and biography. A cook book of simple, but delicious sounding recipes would appeal to many a house wife.

In short these two libraries are a real treasure trove to any who love to read.
