An aggregation of indignant farmers were gathered in Estacada Tuesday, having come to town early that day to sell their wool to several buyers, who had agreed to bid in all wool offered, with 35c per pound as a starting point.

For some reason or other, the buyers did not live up to their agreement, refusing to pay over 32½c. Most of the growers took their wool back home, while a few accepted the price offered.

These same buyers are scheduled to bid in wool at Eagle Creek in a few days, and as cards have already been received by some of the farmers, stating that 35c would be bottom price, many growers are watching the outcome at that point.
