+ Every farmer in Clackamas + County can be more easily inter-+ ested in attending a centrally lo-· cated fair and can also be more easily interested in exhibiting at such a fair. Where a grower has an exhibit, the chances are that he and his family will be present. which guarantees attendance.

The changing of the location of the fair would naturally repre-sent a loss to Canby, but inasmuch as it would be for the public welfare, the majority of peo-ple should be considered.

Again, the question of transportation should be considered with a more centrally located fair, being accessible by more than one railway. This would not only be a convenience to the people, but is due the Portland Railway Light & Power Company, which today profits nothing from the annual fair staged in the extreme corner of the county, although this same company is each year spending hundreds of dollars in agricultural development along its tributary lines and is the heaviest taxpayer in the county

With the Southern Pacific Rail-way, the Willamette Valley Southern Railway and the Portland Light & Power Company, all serving that central part of Clackamas County, within a few miles of Gladstone, such a location would be accessible and a drawing card to the wealthy Molalla and other farming sections, some of which today take little interest in the yearly exhibition. The county owns the Canby

grounds, having purchased same year at a cost of about last \$10,000., but as these grounds can be used for a poor-farm, the poor-farm might as well be established; as it is needed and the county court had this plan in mind when it purchased the grounds.

The expenses of such a change should not be exorbitant, as land could probably be leased and buildings would soon have to be built to replace the old ones at Canby.
